I. Nothing is ever the same after some things happen

- A. You often hear this from lottery winners
- B. Marriage and parenting also have this effect
- C. Jesus' sacrifice for us really changes everything

You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly....God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:6, 8)

II. The center of our universe changes

(Luke 9:23-25)
