I. There is a deep longing in our souls.

A. Something is missing.

"Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher.
"Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless."
(Ecclesiastes 1:2)

He has...set eternity in the human heart... (Ecclesiastes 3:11)

B. History tells the story of our search.

II. We hunger and thirst.

A. We seek to quench our thirst.

Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." (john 4:13-14)
