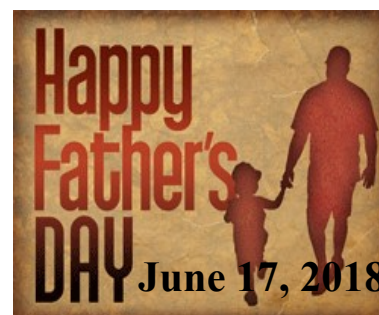
## CALLING ALL YOUTH
